Previously, he had worked as a lawyer in the Illinois Attorney General's Office. He started attending the congregation in the early 1980s.

A few years ago, in an effort to reach out to the community, St. Luke's began hosting Vacation Bible School classes during the summer. The VBS program included a meal for the children, and during those meals, parishioners noticed that some of the children weren't getting enough food at home.

Church members decided to do something about the problem, and they began offering meals for children on Sundays. Tables were set up in the rear of the sanctuary, and the church now serves up to 40 children each week.

"There are a lot of things during the week like school meals and after-school programs. Sometimes on the weekend, there's a gap. We've found (the Sunday meal) is something we could do to be helpful," Denney said.

As St. Luke's begins its second century of service, church members are beginning to feel cramped in their building. Extra chairs have to be hauled into the worship area on some occasions, and the Sunday school classes are also cramped.

The church doesn't want to tear down or add to their existing building, but a new multi-purpose building just to the south of the church could be a possibility.

The congregation has no desire to move to another location.

"We've been in the process of looking for a vision to see what God would have us do. A couple of things came out of that," Denney said. "One is a strong commitment that this is where we need to be. Right in this community doing what we can."
